On Wednesday, June 20th 2018, as part of our Creative Curriculum learning, the children in Key Stage 1 will be treated to a special day of festive learning about India, with activities and experiences facilitated by a talented presenter from Hinduism Education Services. Activities will include storytelling, dressing up in traditional Indian costume for every child, a mock Hindu wedding, dancing the dandiya rasa dance with colourful sticks to music, yoga breathing for relaxation, and much more. Face and hand painting option

As part of the workshop, we will be having a lesson on face and hand painting in the style of Hindu weddings and festivals. The Year 1 and Year 2 pupils will then be able to enjoy having their hands and faces painted! The traditional Indian body painting designs feature delicate patterns made with dots and small swirls above the eyebrows and on the back of the hand. The body paint is water based and washes off easily with soap and water. This activity is optional, and if you would like to opt your child out due to concerns about possible skin allergy, please let us know using the parental permission slip below or via SIMS Agora.
