Covid Contact during the Holidays

Following our recent letter just a reminder to help us all stay safe and enjoy the holidays.

If your child becomes Covid symptomatic and is then tested for Covid, during the holiday period. I need you to take swift action to help us:

- <u>Email</u> using our dedicated email <u>covid@rowlandsgillprimary.org.uk</u> to let us know when symptoms began, the date and time that your child took the test, or is taking a test. This email will be monitored daily during the holidays until, 24th December.
- Email again using the same email address to let us know the outcome of the test as soon as you have it. If it is a positive result we may need to call you – please note this will be from a 'blocked' number.

If we are alerted to a positive case who has had symptoms, we may need to 'close the bubble' and will be working with Public Health to do this.
