## The Runaway Iceberg

Miss Smales will be reading The Runaway Iceberg on Tapestry. Can you listen to the story and talk to you grownups about it? Grown-ups can ask these questions: Why doesn't Gasper dive into the water? Do you think the ice broke quickly or slowly? How do you know? Who helps the penguins? What part of the story did you like best? Why?

We listened to the story of The Three Little Pigs. Can you use the pictures below to cut out and order what happened in the story? What happened first? What happened in the middle of the story and what happened at the end? If you are unable to print, draw some simple pictures of the main parts of the story. Grown-ups can mix them up and encourage the children to re-tell the story using terms 'Once upon a time, first, then, next and finally.'

#### Understanding the world

Can you make your own Frozen Sun catcher? (See Below) Collect some leaves, sticks berries and place them in a bow of shallow water, add a string hoop and let them freeze. When they have frozen you can hang them outside. What happens when the ice starts to melt? Big Schools bird watch: join in the big bird watch and record the birds you see in your garden. Looking after the birds in our garden is very important during the winter, can you help to make your own bird bath? Both links are attached below.

#### Physical Development

Can you pick up cotton wool balls with tweezers or pegs and place them into baskets. You can make this more challenging by placing them into smaller holes.

In the story The Runaway Iceberg, Gaspar had to be brave when swimming, and the three little pigs had to be brave when the big bad wolf came, can you think about a time when you needed to be brave? Perhaps riding a bike for the first time or your first day at school. How did you feel? Can you draw a picture of when you were brave?
