
We will be writing a character description of Om. We will be using expanded noun phrases to create clear and concise descriptions.

In Maths, we will be learning how to:

- Looking at place value to 1000
- Comparing numbers to 1000
- Ordering numbers
- Partitioning numbers
- Mental addition using 3-digit numbers
- Looking at tables 4 and 8 and connecting them to the 2 times tables using doubling

How does our skeleton help us?

Do our bones affect what we can do?

Art and Design


