



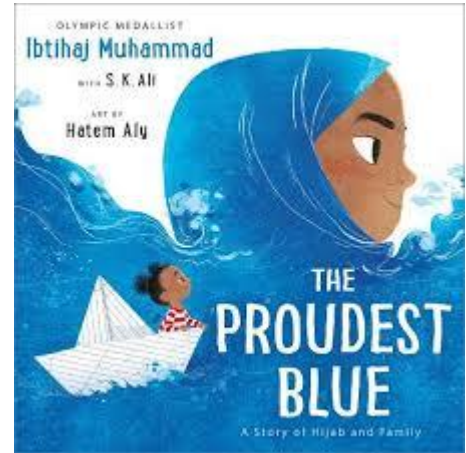

Autumn Term 2025



English

This half term, we are reading *The Proudest Blue* by Ibtihaj Muhammad. It's a story about two sisters, Asiya and Faizah, and how proud Asiya feels wearing her beautiful blue hijab for the first time. Faizah learns that being proud of who you are is something special and strong. We are using this story to help us think about what makes us proud. It could be something we've done, something we're good at or something that makes us unique. In our writing, we are learning to use capital letters at the start of sentences and for the word I, end our sentences with full stops, use adjectives to describe ourselves and our proud moments and write simple sentences that share our thoughts clearly.



We are writing about what we are proud of, just like Asiya, and celebrating the things that make us feel happy and confident.

Maths

This term in Maths, we will be building strong foundations in number and place value by learning to count forwards and backwards, read and write numbers up to 20 and understand concepts like one more and one less. We will explore simple addition and subtraction using objects, pictures and number lines to help us solve problems and understand number bonds. Alongside number work, we'll begin recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes, describing their properties and sorting them into groups. We'll also start learning about measurement by comparing lengths, heights and weights using everyday language and non-standard units. Through fun activities, games and hands-on learning, we'll develop confidence with numbers, improve our mathematical vocabulary and begin solving problems in real-life contexts.



Art

This term in Art, we will be learning how to paint and draw cityscapes, exploring the shapes, colours and patterns found in buildings and urban environments. We will experiment with different materials and techniques to create our own city scenes, using lines, shapes and textures to show detail. We will learn how to mix colours, use bold brushstrokes and understand how artists like Claude Monet and Vincent van Gogh painted city and landscape scenes.



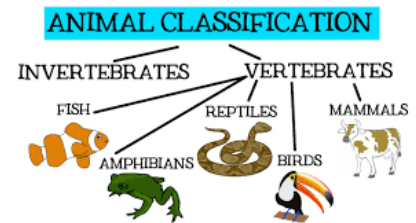
History

This term in History, we will be learning about Florence Nightingale, a significant figure from the past who changed the way hospitals were run and helped improve healthcare. We will explore who Florence Nightingale was, why she is remembered and how she helped soldiers during the Crimean War. We will compare hospitals then and now, understand the importance of hygiene and discover how her work still influences nursing today.



Science

This term in Science, we will be learning about Animals Including Humans. We will explore and identify a variety of common animals such as mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians. We will learn how to group animals based on their features and diets, whether they are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.



Geography

This term in Geography, we will be learning all about Our Local Area. We will explore the places around us such as our school, homes, parks, shops and roads and begin to understand what makes our community special. We will learn to identify human features (like buildings and playgrounds) and physical features (like rivers and hills) and use simple maps, aerial photographs and locational language to describe where things are.

Computing

This term in Computing, we will be learning about Technology Around Us. We will explore what technology is and how it helps us in everyday life, especially in school. We will learn to identify examples of technology in the classroom like computers, tablets and interactive whiteboards and understand what makes something “technology.” We will become familiar with the main parts of a computer, such as the mouse, keyboard and monitor and practise basic skills like clicking, dragging and typing our name. We will also begin to understand how to use technology safely and responsibly, learning simple rules to help keep ourselves and others safe when using devices.
